### INVITATION TO BID

Sealed bids will be received by **CITY OF ELBERTON, GA** for the construction of **WATER TREATMENT PLANT – 2019 CHEMICAL FEED IMPROVEMENTS** at 203 Elbert Street, Elberton, GA 30635 until 10:00 AM local time, on September 26, 2019 and then at said time and place publicly opened and read aloud.

The work will consist of installing new dry chemical feed system (powdered activated carbon), replacing valve actuators, miscellaneous building improvements and all related appurtenances.

Payment for the work will be made periodically on the basis of Contractor's Applications for Payment processed by the Engineer.

A non-mandatory pre-bid meeting will be held at City of Elberton Water Treatment Plant, 1321 Filter Plant Drive Elberton, GA 30635 on September 11, 2019 at 10:00 AM local time.

Bids must include a Bid Bond in an amount of not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount bid. All bonds must be countersigned by a Georgia Resident Agent. A Performance Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the bid and a Payment Bond in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the amount of the bid must be furnished by the successful bidder.

Bidders must comply with Executive Order No. 11246 as amended, entitled "Equal Employment Opportunity" and with the Copeland Anti-Kickback Act (18 U.S.C. 874) as supplemented in Department of Labor Regulations (29 CFR, Part 3).

Bidders must comply with all provisions of the "Georgia Security and Immigration Compliance Act" of 2007. Bids must include a completed Federal Work Authorization Contractor Affidavit as shown in Section CM1.

This project is GEFA funded. The Bidders must comply with DBE & EEO requirements; Davis Bacon and Related Acts; Wage Rate Determination; and EPA Consolidated Appropriations Act 2014 that includes an American Iron & Steel requirement.

The right is reserved by the Owner to delay the award of the Contract for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of opening of the bids, during which time bids shall remain open and not subject to withdrawal. The right is also reserved to reject any and all bids and to waive any and all technicalities or informalities.
