

CITY OF ELBERTON
WORK SESSION MEETING OF THE ELBERTON MAYOR AND COUNCIL
Monday, April 26, 2010 – 5:30 p.m.

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof the Work Session Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton convened at Noon on Monday, April 26, 2010, in the staff development room of the Municipal Building, 203 Elbert Street with Mayor Guest presiding.

Present were: Council Members Butler, Colquitt, and Paul; City Manager Dunn, City Clerk Churney, Police Chief Mark Welsh, City Attorney Phelps, and Assistant City Attorney Campbell. Absent were: Council Members Hunt and Seymour.

Mayor Guest called the meeting to order. Council Member Paul led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer.

City Manager Dunn presented the following items for discussion relating the agenda for the regular meeting of May 3:

1. Ordinance 2159 amending Chapter 22, Land Use pertaining to the soil erosion and sediment control regulations as required by the Georgia Department of Natural Resources.
2. Ordinance 2160 amending Chapter 38, Utilities with regard to penalties.

The following matters were discussion by Council and Reports from Staff:

1. Budget Calendar for Fiscal Year 2011.
2. Personnel Policies and Procedures Manual/Handbook.

Any other matters that may properly come before Council:

1. Report on ElbertonNET 2010 Expansion Project.
2. Parking recommendations from the Elberton Police Department for the Elberton Housing Projects and Almond Street areas. The residence in the area have complained that non-residence are parking and hanging out in the areas, which is leading to fights and crime. The department recommends restricting parking on certain streets at certain times during the day. Chief Welsh also suggested scheduling the contractual housing officers to patrol the areas at designated times during the weekends.
 - a. Almond Street Area – restrict parking to daytime only to certain streets, see map A.
 - b. Second Street, Third Street and Fountain Street – prohibit parking on designated sides of the street, see map B.

There being no further discussion, the work session was adjourned.
