

CALLED MEETING OF THE ELBERTON CITY COUNCIL

Thursday, January 10, 2008 - 5:00 p.m.

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof the Called Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton convened at 5:00 p.m. on January 10, 2008, in the staff development room of the municipal building, 203 Elbert Street with Mayor Guest presiding.

Present were: Council Members Butler, Colquitt, Hunt, Paul and Seymour; City Attorney Phelps and City Manager Dunn.

A notice of called meeting was issued in accordance with law for the purpose of discussing potential matters of litigation with the city attorney and any other matters that may properly come before Council. Mayor Guest called the meeting to order. Mayor Pro tempore Colquitt led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and City Attorney Phelps led the assembly in prayer.

City Attorney Phelps asked to move into executive session. Council Member Hunt made the motion to close the called meeting and move into executive session, as allowed by O.C.G.A. Section 50-14-2 to discuss potential litigation. Mayor Pro tempore Colquitt seconded the motion to close and enter into executive session. Council Member Hunt motioned to move out of executive session, with Mayor Pro tempore Colquitt seconding the motion. Mayor Guest reported that no action was taken at this time.
