

CITY OF ELBERTON
WORK SESSION MEETING OF THE ELBERTON MAYOR AND COUNCIL
Monday, October 25, 2010 – 5:30 p.m.

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof the Work Session Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton convened at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, October 25, 2010, in the staff development room of the Municipal Building, 203 Elbert Street with Mayor Guest presiding.

Present were: Council Members Butler, Colquitt, Hunt, and Paul; City Manager Dunn, City Clerk Churney, City Attorney Phelps, Assistant City Attorney Graves and Shane Scoggins with the Elberton Star. Absent was: Council Member Seymour.

Mayor Guest called the meeting to order. Council Member Paul led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer.

City Manager Dunn presented the following items for discussion relating the agenda for the regular meeting of November 1:

1. Consideration of placing Ordinance 2165 on first reading to amend the zoning map to rezone 43 Laurel Drive.
2. Consideration of accepting the minutes and decisions of the Elberton Historic Preservation Commission meeting of October 12, 2010.
3. Consideration of adopting the calendar of holidays for 2011.
4. Consideration of adopting the calendar of regular and work session meeting dates for 2011. Mayor Guest asked Council to consider scheduling the work sessions on an "as needed" basis.
5. Consideration of adopting interconnection standards for solar power generation. City Manager Dunn recommended adopting the standards to comply with the Georgia Cogeneration and Distributed Generation Act of 2001.
6. Consideration of authorization to renew the 1996 Intergovernmental Agreement regarding building inspector and fire safety services.

Council Member Colquitt inquired about extending the reward for vandalism to all city properties instead of just the walking trail due to some graffiti at Hickory Drive. City Manager Dunn stated that he would review the policy.

There being no further discussion, the work session was adjourned.
