

**CITY OF ELBERTON**  
**WORK SESSION MEETING OF THE ELBERTON MAYOR AND COUNCIL**

Monday, October 26, 2009 – 5:30 p.m.

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof the Work Session Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton convened at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, October 26, 2009, in the staff development room of the Municipal Building, 203 Elbert Street with Mayor Guest presiding.

Present were: Council Members Butler, Colquitt, Hunt, Seymour and Paul; City Manager Dunn, City Attorney Phelps, Assistant City Attorney Graves and City Clerk Churney.

Mayor Guest called the meeting to order. Mayor Pro tempore Paul led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance and in prayer.

City Manager Dunn presented the following items for discussion relating the agenda for the regular meeting of November 2, 2009:

1. Resolution authorizing construction of an extension of the existing telecommunications system. As privilege of the chair, Mayor Guest removed the item for further consideration. Mayor Guest polled Council and the vote was unanimous to place the item on the November 30 Work Session.
2. Resolution declaring intent to use tax exempt financing. As privilege of the chair, Mayor Guest removed the item for further consideration. Mayor Guest polled Council and the vote was unanimous to place the item on the November 30 Work Session.
3. Regular and Work Session dates for 2010 meetings. Council proposed changing the January 3, 2011 Regular Meeting to January 10, 2011 and the December 27, 2010 Work Session to January 4, 2011. Council concurred.
4. Holidays for 2010. No changes were made.
5. U. S. Department of Justice acceptance of annexation Ordinance 2157.
6. Planning Commission minutes of October 19, 2009.
7. Request from Main Street to close portions of city streets for the Kiwanis Christmas Parade on December 3, 2009 at 6:30 p.m.

The following matters were discussion by Council:

1. Council Member Hunt and staff recommended to the Planning Commission to re-zone a portion of Oglesby Boulevard in Ward 2. The Planning Commission will consider the re-zone on November 16, 2009

Mayor Guest administered the Oath of Election Superintendent to City Clerk Churney. The Municipal General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2009 for Ward 1.

City Manager Dunn added that the City conducted an Energy Audit for Elbert Memorial Hospital on Tuesday, October 19.

There being no further discussion, the work session was adjourned.
