The City of Elberton is currently seeking qualified applicants for a Journeyman Lineman.

NATURE OF WORK

This position is responsible for installing, maintaining and repairing all transmission and distribution electrical systems and associated equipment, both overhead and underground, while utilizing line trucks, aerial boom, lifts and wire pulling equipment.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Applicant must be able to work with hands above head for extended periods of time. Must be able to walk, climb, and work from ladders, or at various heights, on uneven and slippery surfaces, performing manual/physically demanding work under unfavorable weather conditions while handling dangerous equipment or material. Due to the capacity of existing equipment the weight of the incumbent should not exceed approximately 240 pounds. Applicant must not have fear of heights. Must be able to lift, move and maneuver heavy weights of up to 50 pounds on an infrequent basis, but moderate weights on a frequent basis.

EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE

Applicant must be a High School or GED graduate, hold a valid Commercial Driver License Certification, and pass a background drug screen. Applicant must possess a Journeyman Lineman certification with a minimum of five years experience in construction and maintenance of an electric power distribution system.
