The City of Elberton is currently seeking qualified applicants for a full-time position. We offer a competitive compensation package including several fringe benefits such as Paid Vacation and Sick Leave, Paid Holidays, Group Medical and Dental Insurance, Employer Provided Life Insurance and Long-term Disability Insurance, and Two Retirement Plans—a defined benefit pension plan at no cost to the employee, and a defined contribution plan that matches employee voluntary contributions up to 6% of salary.

Public Works Department: Facilities Maintenance Technician.

This position is a skilled position that will, under direction of the construction manager, construct, renovate, and maintain several city buildings and facilities. The buildings and facilities are brought to or kept at a sufficient level of repair so that the spaces are attractive and functional for lease tenants or for city workers, customers, or visitors. This works includes lighting systems, heating, ventilation, and cooling systems, plumbing systems, and performs technical maintenance and repair tasks as appropriate. Projects include new construction, fit-out of shell spaces, renovation of existing spaces and major maintenance of existing buildings and infrastructure.

Applicants must have knowledge of building codes and safety standards, good working knowledge of construction, mechanics, carpentry, electrical, plumbing, masonry and other trades as they relate to the position. Three years' experience in the operation of light construction equipment and power tools, or any equivalent combination of education, training, and experience which provides the requisite knowledge, skills, and abilities for this position, plus the ability to read and write English is required. Expected rate of pay is \$15.00 to \$19.00 per hour depending on skill level and years of experience.
