

Journeyman Lineman or Apprentice Lineman

The City of Elberton is currently seeking qualified applicants for a full-time position. We offer a competitive compensation package including several fringe benefits such as Paid Vacation and Sick Leave, Paid Holidays, Group Medical and Dental Insurance, Employer Provided Life Insurance and Long-term Disability Insurance, and Two Retirement Plans—a defined benefit pension plan at no cost to the employee, and a defined contribution plan that matches employee voluntary contributions up to 6% of salary.

Elberton Utilities Electric Division: Journeyman Lineman.

This position is responsible for installing, maintaining and repairing all distribution electrical systems and associated equipment, both overhead and underground. The department uses various specialized equipment including line trucks, aerial bucket trucks, and wire pulling equipment. Applicant must possess a Journeyman Lineman certification with a minimum of four years' experience in construction and maintenance of an electric power distribution system. Expected rate of pay ranges from \$28.00 to \$35.00 per hour dependent upon experience and qualifications.

Interested persons not meeting this experience level may apply for an **Apprenticeship Lineman Program**. Candidates with some previous experience in electrical work or who have an interest in electric line work may be considered for an apprenticeship. This program is four years in length and trains an individual in the operation and maintenance of an electric distribution system. Candidates may be required to submit to an aptitude examination to evaluate candidates for job-related skills in mathematics, geometry, units of measure, reading comprehension, and logical thinking. Expected rate of pay ranges from \$16.00 to \$20.00 dependent upon skill level, and pay will progress annually upon completion of steps in the apprenticeship program.
