The City of Elberton is currently seeking qualified applicants for a firefighter.

JOB SUMMARY

An individual in this job classification is responsible for performing general fire work in the protection of life and property endangered by fire and other emergency situations. This involves the education, prevention and extinguishing of fires and the precaution to prevent rekindling. The work involves an element of personal danger.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

Individual must have knowledge in firefighting techniques that are usually obtained while participating in a volunteer firefighting program. Applicants may be expected to participate in a written and agility examination in order to provide evidence of basic firefighting skills as well as meet the minimum physical fitness requirements as prescribed by the Firefighter Standards and Training Council.

EDUCATION, TRAINING, AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

Individual must be at least 18 years of age; a citizen of the United States; hold a high school diploma or equivalent; and hold a valid Georgia driver's license.

Other supplemental education expected upon hire: minimum yearly training hours as stated in the Standard Operating Procedures Manual. Part of that training will consist of 24 hours set forth by the Georgia Firefighters Standards and Training.
