<u>Wastewater Plant Operator 3 or Trainee</u> – An individual in this job classification is responsible for the daily operations of a specified treatment plant. The job of wastewater treatment plant operator in a small municipality carries with it many duties and responsibilities. Some are obvious, many are not. All too often the operator is not just the operator, but also laborer, lab technician and mechanic.

Operator 3 – successful completion of level III operator state qualification certification within 12 months of employment with a minimum 3 months experience in the operation of a treatment facility.

Operator Trainee – is an entry-level position; employee must attend 40 hours basic operator training course and challenge level III testing within six months of employment in the operation of a treatment facility.

This position is an entry level position at Grade 12 and the salary ranges from \$37,964 to \$53,150 depending on experience and qualifications.
