<u>Wastewater Plant Operator 3 or Trainee</u> – An individual in this job classification is responsible for the daily operations of a specified treatment plant. The job of wastewater treatment plant operator in a small municipality carries with it many duties and responsibilities. All too often the operator is not just the operator, but also laborer, lab technician and mechanic.

Operator Trainee – is an entry-level position; employee must attend 40 hours basic operator training course and challenge level III testing within six months of employment in the operation of a treatment facility.

Operator 3 – successful completion of level III operator state qualification certification within 12 months of employment with a minimum 3 months experience in the operation of a treatment facility.
